Thank you for returning the tag you recovered in the Trinity River Basin.

We place tags on a portion of the returning adult salmon and steelhead to determine their respective run size, angler harvest and spawner escapement each year. Reward tags and non-reward tags are needed to achieve this, and we encourage anglers to return all tags. **Reward tags are imprinted with "Reward," and will be paid whether tags were recovered by angling, found attached to dead fish or found loose/unattached.** Tags removed from fish caught-and-released no longer provide useful information for us, so we encourage anglers not to remove tags from live fish. However, rewards are paid on these tags and there is no penalty for removing them. **Return tags in the season you collect them. Tags returned out of season will not be eligible for reward.**
